#### Introduction

This manual provides detailed information on the installation, maintenance, usage, and warranty details of Fortress Hockey Goals supplied by Play Hard Sports Equipment Australia. Our Fortress Goals are designed for durability and performance, suitable for both amateur and professional use.

#### **Product Details:**

The Fortress Hockey Goals are designed and manufactured by Play Hard Sports Equipment using Structural Grade Aluminium. It is an FIH-regulation-compliant goal designed for top-level competition featured in the XXI Commonwealth Games, Gold Coast 2018. All the materials used in our products have been locally sourced.

- Rubber Castors Wheels at the back for moving the goals

# Installation Instructions:

#### 1. Unboxing the pallet:

- The goals are flat packed in either a single pallet or 2 pallets.
- Please read the instructions manual before commencing the assembly work.
- Refer to the supplied packing lists and account for all the items listed in the packing list.
- Please be careful not to scratch the frames while unboxing.




Figure 1: Fortress Packing List



#### 2. Assembling the frame:

- Lay the two Side Frames upright and place the Weighted Back Panel at the Side Frames using M10 x 30mm S/S Hex Bolt and Spring Washer.
- Then, Insert the Straight Joiner on top of the Side Frames and attach them using M10 x 30 mm S/S Hex Bolt and Spring Washer.
- Place the Cross-bar Frame on top of the Side Frames and attach them using the bolt kit.
- Properly tighten the bolts, until the frame is secured.




Figure 2: Fortress Hockey Assembled




#### 3. Attaching the net:

1. To attach the net, use the rods supplied to feed across the groove in the frame.

1830 mm - Back Panel and Cross Bar

1145mm – Side Panel 840mm – Upright Section



#### 4. Attaching the Wheels

2. To attach the rubber castor wheel, use the M10 x 30mm S/S Hex Bolt and Spring Washer.

# **Operating Instructions**

- Please refer to the instructions before moving the goals.
- Moving the goal is a two-person operation.
- The goal can be moved by tipping the goal backwards onto the two wheels at the rear of the backboard.
- To tip the goal
  - Stand facing each upright
  - Tip the goal slowly backwards
  - While holding the uprights, move to the side to gradually lower the goal.
  - The wheels are set off the ground and will make contact when the goal is tilted about 45 degrees.
- The goal can be moved by holding the ends of the net support rail or lowering the goal further so the crossbar can be held.
- To stand the goal upright
  - o Hold the net rail and raise it
  - As the goal tips upright, place one foot on the top of the board to act as a counterweight and raise till it is fully upright
- Avoid dragging or dropping the goal to prevent damage. This will void the warranty.



#### Maintenance:

All our Goals are designed to require a minimal level of maintenance. However, it is advisable to do:

- **Regular Inspections**: Check for any signs of wear or damage. Tighten bolts and replace nets or padding as needed.
- Cleaning: Clean the posts with a damp cloth to remove dirt. Avoid harsh chemicals that could damage the paint. If the poles have been scratched over the intended period of use, lightly scuff the area and apply 2 coats of white gloss paint (spray painted).
- **Weather Protection**: Consider using protective covers during extreme weather to extend the lifespan of the equipment.

### Safety Guidelines

1. Supervision:

- Supervise play, especially with younger players, to ensure safety.
- Prevent players from hanging from the ring or climbing up the posts to prevent serious injury.
- 2. During visual inspection, if the bolts are loosened, the goal should not be used until they have been repaired.
